

## USGA. Rules Govern All Play

### Local Rules

- Embedded ball rule is in effect
- Red *penalty areas* defined by red lines or red stakes.
- Yellow *penalty areas* defined by yellow lines or yellow stakes.
- Relief from exposed ledge on fairways, planted flowers and shrubs near clubhouse, 1<sup>st</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> tees, and newly planted trees (tagged).
- Any stone wall to be played as an integral part of the course.
- Red *penalty area* behind the 7<sup>th</sup> green. If point of entry cannot be determined player may use the drop area provided.
- Drop area behind the 9<sup>th</sup> green: may be used for relief from the clubhouse, walkway, or decorative bushes *within* the marked area. (Marked area is indicated by 4 yellow dots.)
